Summary:

The Albuquerque Bernalillo County Water Utility Authority (Water Authority) issued a Request for Bids (RFB) for Construction to solicit bids from qualified vendors to provide restoration services for the Southside Water Reclamation Plant (SWRP) Outfall Project for floodplain restoration services that creates and improves up to 11 acres of floodplain habitat upstream and downstream of the existing, Water Authority SWRP outfall.

The RFB was advertised in the local newspaper and available for download on the Water Authority's eProcurement website, BidSync. Bids were opened for the above-referenced project on Tuesday, June 18, 2024, at 1:30 p.m. The bids received were reviewed and evaluated by the Water Authority and Hazen & Sawyer.

CF Padilla, LLC was the apparent low bidder for this project. Following the review and evaluation, CF Padilla, LLC's bid was deemed responsive. A summary of the bids received is attached. The Water Authority staff requests approval to proceed with award to CF Padilla, LLC

This approval is intended to delegate signature authority to the Executive Director to enter into an Agreement with the selected contractor, approve any change orders or amendments to the Agreement as necessary to complete the project and to provide restoration services for this project based on the results of the RFB, B2024000014.

Hazen and Sawyer (Hazen) reviewed the bids received on June 18, 2024 for the above referenced project. The bids listed from apparent low bidder to highest, including owner directed allowances and New Mexico Gross Receipts Tax, are shown in **Table 1**.

Table 1: Summary of Bids

CF Padilla, LLC was found to be the most responsive low bidder. The following items were used in the review and determination of the most responsible low bidder (attached for reference):

- Bid Tabulation
- Bid Package Submitted by Prime
- Reference Check

Please note that Hazen contacted the references for the projects listed on the Bid Proposal.CF Padilla has been in business since 2013, is an 8(a) Certified Small Disadvantaged Business, and currently has a Certificate of Contractor Registration from the Labor Relations Division of the New Mexico Workforce Solutions Department.

Under this proposal, 64% (i.e., \$3,967,918.00) of the work will be self-performed. The remaining work (i.e., 36%, \$2,243,870.00) will be performed by their subcontractor, Aquatic Consultants, to perform planting activities.



Based on our overall review of these items, we recommend the Albuquerque Bernalillo County Water Utility Authority award a construction contract to CF Padilla, LLC. for the **Southside Water Reclamation Plant Outfall Restoration** project. 

- Could you briefly describe the project undertaken by CF Padilla?
 The project was a moist soil unit infrastructure upgrade project related to several manmade constructed wetlands that provide inundation for waterfowl habitat in the winter. Work included piping and levee infrastructure upgrades and did not include any revegetation efforts within CF Padilla's scope.
- What is the project's current progress and timeline?
 The project was completed in May 2023 and is out of the warranty period.
- Can you provide the initial and final construction costs? How many change orders, if any, were requested by CF Padilla?

Initial: Interviewee could not recall.

Final: approximately 6.5MUSD

Couple of change orders: one was owner directed, whereas the other was requested by CF Padilla for schedule extension due to weather with an approximate amount of 20 to 40k.

- Was CF Padilla the main contractor, and who was the foreman you collaborated with?
 Yes, CF Padilla was the prime contractor and the foreman they collaborated with was Clint Autrey.
- Were there any construction challenges, and how did CF Padilla address them?

 The interviewee could not speak to any significant construction challenges. Those that he recalls were minor and were easily resolved via collaboration.
- Did the project require dewatering or working in the wet, and if so, what was CF Padilla's method and effectiveness?
 - No dewatering nor working in the wet was required for construction of the project. If any flooding was encountered, it was pluvial as opposed to fluvial in nature.
- Is the project in the warranty, maintenance, or establishment phase, and how is CF Padilla performing?
 - They were good to work with and responsive, despite being busy on other construction projects elsewhere.
- Were regulatory agencies involved during construction, and how did CF Padilla manage these interactions?
 - There were minor interactions with USFWS due to a threatened and endangered plant species. CF Padilla was respectful to the agencies and adhered to the environmental commitments during construction.
- What are your thoughts on CF Padilla's work quality and commitment to client service?

 The interviewee was impressed by their work during and following construction and hopes that they continue to bid on their projects in the future.

Thanks for the quick reply. I've provided the questions that we have below. Generally speaking, these questions are intended to be open-ended and if you could elaborate further (1 to 2 sentence max) we would greatly appreciate it.

- Could you briefly describe the project undertaken by CF Padilla?

 The project constructed by CF Padilla was the Socorro Main Canal Channel Lining Project Phase 1.

 This project was to shotcrete about 1.1 miles of the Socorro Main Canal, and complete upgrades to the existing infrastructure in the canal such as turnouts, check structures, and catwalks.
- What is the project's current progress and timeline?

This project was completed, and final closeout was on March 26th, 2024. MRGCD's construction timeframe is from November to March. CF Padilla was able to complete this project within the project schedule.

 Can you provide the initial and final construction costs? How many change orders, if any, were requested by CF Padilla?

The initial construction cost was \$5,509,075.26 and the final construction cost was \$5,114,939.40. There was only one change order requested by CF Padilla for this project.

- Was CF Padilla the main contractor, and who was the foreman you collaborated with?
 CF Padilla was the main contractor for this project, and our main contact for this project was Division Manager, Clint Autrey.
- Were there any construction challenges, and how did CF Padilla address them?

 During the installation of the turnout structures, there were utility lines that were not detected around the existing structures. CF Padilla was able to coordinate with the utility company and the MRGCD to repair the broken lines promptly and continue to work vigilantly.
- Did the project require dewatering or working in the wet, and if so, what was CF Padilla's method and effectiveness?

The project did not require dewatering, since the work was conducted during the irrigation offseason. During rainfall events CF Padilla used pumps to dewater areas within the channel and their method was effective as they were able to stay on schedule.

 Is the project in the warranty, maintenance, or establishment phase, and how is CF Padilla performing?

The project is currently in the warranty phase, since its completion in March of 2024.

 Were regulatory agencies involved during construction, and how did CF Padilla manage these interactions?

CF Padilla managed interactions with other regulatory agencies on a regular basis, through email, phone, and in-person.

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into on the date last entered below, by and between the Albuquerque Bernalillo County Water Utility Authority, hereinafter called OWNER, and CF Padilla LLC, hereinafter called CONTRACTOR.

That Owner and Contractor for the consideration stated herein mutually agree as follows:

- 1. STATEMENT OF WORK: CONTRACTOR shall furnish all supervision, technical personnel, labor, materials, machinery, tools, equipment and services, including utility and transportation services, and perform and complete the Work for the construction of the above-referenced Project and any authorized supplemental work, all in strict accordance with the Contract Documents.
- **2. CONTRACT TIME:** The Contract Time will commence on the day indicated in the Notice to Proceed, as specified in the General Terms and Conditions, and continue for a period of 285 days. Changes to the Contract Time are allowed only as provided in the General Terms and Conditions.

Liquidated damages, in the amount per day of One Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$1,000.00) will be assessed against the Contractor for each calendar day, or portion thereof, the Work has not achieved Substantial Completion after expiration of that portion of the Contract Time allotted for construction, including any approved extension of time granted. Further, liquidated damages, in the amount per day of One Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$1,000.00) will be assessed against the Contractor for each calendar day, or portion thereof, the punch list items listed as incomplete and attached to the Certificate of Substantial Completion are not completed or corrected after expiration of the time allotted for completion and correction, including any approved extension of time granted. These liquidated damages are cumulative. See the General Terms and Conditions, referenced in Part IV of this RFB, for additional information terms relating to liquidated damages.

- **3. CONTRACT PRICE:** OWNER will pay CONTRACTOR for the performance of the Contract in current funds, as provided in the Contract Documents, the amount of Six Million, Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand, Eleven and 84/100 Dollars (\$6,750,011.84), which amount includes any applicable New Mexico Gross Receipts Taxes.
- 4. NON-APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS: Notwithstanding any provision in this Contract to the contrary, payments hereunder are contingent upon the Water Authority Board making the necessary appropriations. If sufficient appropriations are not made, this Contract may be terminated at the end of the Water Authority's then current fiscal year upon written notice given by OWNER to CONTRACTOR. Such event shall not constitute an event of default and all payment obligations of OWNER and all of its interest in this Contract will cease upon the date of termination. OWNER'S determination regarding appropriations shall be accepted by CONTRACTOR and shall be final.
- 5. COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS: In providing the Work outlined herein, Contractor shall comply with all applicable laws, ordinances, and codes of the federal, State, and local governments, including, but not limited to the New Mexico Human Rights Act, Title VII of the

federal Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, and all federal, State and local statutes, regulations and executive orders relating to civil rights. Furthermore, this Agreement must be conducted in accordance with mandatory applicable federal laws and regulations as set forth in Exhibit A, Water Authority Federal Funding Contract Addendum.

 - the General Terms and Conditions, as supplemented in Part II of the RFB
 - the Referenced Standard Specifications (as updated and amended).
 - the Instructions to Bidders (Part I of the RFB)
 - additional forms and instructions in the RFB
 - the Advertisement for Bids
- 6.1 Construction detail drawings shall govern over scaled dimensions and over other drawings. Dimensions given on plans or which can be calculated will govern over scaled dimensions.
