**TITLE: C-24-25 – Approval of Contract with New Mexico Underground Utilities Inc. as a result of B2025000003 South Valley Drinking Water Project Phase 8A and 8B.1, Project No. 03117.00**

**ACTION: Recommend Approval**

**SUMMARY:**

The Albuquerque Bernalillo County Water Utility Authority (Water Authority) issued a Request for Bids (RFB) for Construction to solicit bids from qualified vendors to expand the existing water system to west of Coors Blvd and east of Douglas Road in the South Valley. Base bid includes installation of approximately 18,000 linear feet of 6", 8", 10", and 12" PVC waterline, as well as new fire hydrants, combination air release vales, gate valves, service lines and water meter boxes. Additive bid alternates I, II, and III include installation of 10,200 of 6" and 12" waterlines, fire hydrants, combination air release vales, gate valves, service lines and water meter boxes.

The RFB was advertised in the local newspaper and available for download on the Water Authority's eProcurement website, BidSync. Bids were opened for the above-referenced project on Wednesday, August 14<sup>th</sup>, 2024, at 1:30 p.m. The bids received were reviewed and evaluated by the Water Authority and Smith Engineering.

New Mexico Underground Utilities Inc. was the apparent low bidder for this project. Following the review and evaluation, New Mexico Underground Utilities Inc.'s bid was deemed responsive. A summary of the bids received is attached. The Water Authority staff requests approval to proceed with award to New Mexico Underground Utilities Inc.

This approval is intended to delegate signature authority to the Executive Director to enter into an Agreement with the selected contractor, approve any change orders or amendments to the Agreement as necessary to complete the project and to provide restoration services for this project based on the results of the RFB, B2025000003.

**THIS AGREEMENT** is made and entered into on the date last entered below, by and between the Albuquerque Bernalillo County Water Utility Authority, hereinafter called OWNER, and New Mexico Underground Utilities, Inc., hereinafter called CONTRACTOR.

That Owner and Contractor for the consideration stated herein mutually agree as follows:

**1. STATEMENT OF WORK:** CONTRACTOR shall furnish all supervision, technical personnel, labor, materials, machinery, tools, equipment and services, including utility and transportation services, and perform and complete the Work for the construction of the above-referenced Project and any authorized supplemental work, all in strict accordance with the Contract Documents.

**2. CONTRACT TIME:** The Contract Time will commence on the day indicated in the Notice to Proceed, as specified in the General Terms and Conditions, and continue for a period of 427 days. Changes to the Contract Time are allowed only as provided in the General Terms and Conditions.

Liquidated damages, in the amount per day of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) will be assessed against the Contractor for each calendar day, or portion thereof, the Work has not achieved Substantial Completion after expiration of that portion of the Contract Time allotted for construction, including any approved extension of time granted. Further, liquidated damages, in the amount per day of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) will be assessed against the Contractor for each calendar day, or portion thereof, the punch list items listed as incomplete and attached to the Certificate of Substantial Completion are not completed or corrected after expiration of the time allotted for completion and correction, including any approved extension of time granted. These liquidated damages are cumulative. See the General Terms and Conditions, referenced in Part IV of this RFB, for additional information terms relating to liquidated damages.

**3. CONTRACT PRICE:** OWNER will pay CONTRACTOR for the performance of the Contract in current funds, as provided in the Contract Documents, the amount of Six Million, Seven Hundred Fifty-Five Thousand, Three Hundred Fifty-One and 91/100 Dollars (\$6,755,351.91), which amount includes any applicable New Mexico Gross Receipts Taxes.

**4. NON-APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS:** Notwithstanding any provision in this Contract to the contrary, payments hereunder are contingent upon the Water Authority Board making the necessary appropriations. If sufficient appropriations are not made, this Contract may be terminated at the end of the Water Authority's then current fiscal year upon written notice given by OWNER to CONTRACTOR. Such event shall not constitute an event of default and all payment obligations of OWNER and all of its interest in this Contract will cease upon the date of termination. OWNER'S determination regarding appropriations shall be accepted by CONTRACTOR and shall be final.

**5. COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS:** In providing the Work outlined herein, Contractor shall comply with all applicable laws, ordinances, and codes of the federal, State, and local governments, including, but not limited to the New Mexico Human Rights Act, Title VII of the federal Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, and all federal, State and local statutes, regulations and executive orders relating to civil rights. Furthermore, this

Agreement must be conducted in accordance with mandatory applicable federal laws and regulations as set forth in Exhibit A, Water Authority Federal Funding Contract Addendum.

**6. CONTRACT DOCUMENTS:** The Contract Documents consist of the following, which are as fully a part of the Contract as if attached to this Agreement or repeated herein, and have precedence in the following order:

- Modifications to the Contract Documents
- the Agreement (Along with Exhibit A, Federal Funding Contract Addendum), insurance certificates and surety bonds
- Contractor's Bid Proposal, except as provided below
- the Addenda to the Bid Documents.
- the Special Instructions (Part II of the RFB)
- the Project Technical Specifications attached as Appendix A to the Bid Documents
- the Drawings attached as Appendix B to the Bid Documents
- the Federal Funding Solicitation Addendum attached as Appendix C to the Bid Documents
- the General Terms and Conditions, as supplemented in Part II of the RFB (as updated and amended).
- the Referenced Standard Specifications (as updated and amended).
- the Instructions to Bidders (Part I of the RFB)
- additional forms and instructions in the RFB
- the Advertisement for Bids

**6.1** Construction detail drawings shall govern over scaled dimensions and over other drawings. Dimensions given on plans or which can be calculated will govern over scaled dimensions.

**6.2** Anything in the CONTRACTOR'S Bid Proposal which alters or provides a condition to the Bid Documents will not take precedence over any part of the Bid Documents unless it is specifically so provided in the Agreement, or a Modification to the Contract Documents, signed by the parties.

**6.3** All definitions and terms set forth in the General Terms and Conditions and the Procurement Ordinance are applicable to the Bid and Contract Documents.

Smith Engineering (Smith) has attached a tabulation of the bid received including the Engineer’s Opinion of Probable Construction Cost. Items highlighted in yellow indicate a mathematical error in the proposal. Mathematical errors did not affect the outcome of the bid tabulation.

The low bidder for the project is **NMUU, Inc.** Smith carefully reviewed the documents and determined the following:

- The Bid Proposal was signed by Casey Thompson, Vice President.
- NMUU, Inc. is a listed contractor in the State of New Mexico, License No. 384433, License Classifications GF98 and EE98. Smith verified this information with the PSI License Management website (<http://public.psiexams.com/search.jsp>).
- The NM Department of Workforce Solutions listed a Registration No. of 1749120150318 for NMUU, Inc. Smith verified this information with the Workforce Solutions website (<https://www.dws.state.nm.us/pwaa/LRDEmployer/PW/Search/LEFSearch.ASPX>)

Along with the signed Bid Proposal form, NMUU. submitted the following as part of their bid package:

- Unfair Business Practices Disclosure Form

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- SFPA-1 Form/Subcontractor Listing
  - Bid Bond
  - Disclosure of Lobbying Activities Form
  - Acknowledgement of addendum 1.

NMUU Inc. has submitted the lowest responsive bid. Smith is not aware of any other information that would preclude the award of a contract to NMUU, Inc. Smith therefore recommends award to NMUU, Inc. for the amount of **\$6,755,353.19 (incl. NMGRT) for the base bid and all additive alternates assuming the Water Authority has the necessary funds.**

Note that ADAME, Inc was deemed as non-responsive due to the following items not being included in the submitted project bid.

- The submitted bid was not signed by an individual authorized to sign on behalf of the business.
- Addenda Acknowledgement
- Subcontractors Fair Practice Act Listing Form
- Disclosure of Lobbying Activities Form
- Unfair Business Practice Disclosure Form

In addition to recommending this award, Smith has reviewed NMUU's bid proposal for "unbalanced bid amounts". Smith did not identify any items with "unbalanced bid amounts"

- In order to submit a Bid Proposal valued at more than sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) for this Project, which is subject to the Public Works Minimum Wage Act (Sections 13-4-10 to 13-4-17 NMSA 1978), Bidder, serving as a prime contractor or not, shall be registered with the Labor Relations Division of the New Mexico Workforce Solutions Department.
- Prevailing wage rates as indicated in the Wage Rate determination contained in Part IV of this RFB shall apply. There is no representation on the part of the Water Authority that labor can be obtained at the hourly rates shown. It is the responsibility of Bidders to inform themselves as to local labor conditions and prospective changes or adjustments of wage rates and fringe benefit rates. No increase in the Contract Price shall be allowed or authorized on account of the payment of wage rates or fringe benefit rates in excess of those listed.

- All license and royalty fees for products or for processes shall be paid directly by the Contractor.
- All utilities and water for the Project must be supplied by the Contractor in compliance with the City of Albuquerque's Water Conservation Landscaping and Water Waste Ordinance, Sections 6-1-1-1, et seq. ROA 1994, and the Water Authority's Waste Water Ordinance, Sections 4-1-1 et seq.
- If any Allowances are included at the end of the Bid Proposal, they are estimated dollar amounts. The actual dollar amounts reimbursed may be less than, equal to, or greater than the stated allowances. The Water Authority shall reimburse the actual cost based on invoices.
- The bid amount submitted by the Bidder shall exclude any applicable gross receipts tax or applicable local option tax, which shall be stated separately, if applicable.

**Gross Receipts Tax Increases or Decreases and Limitations on Payment of Increases.**

The amount of all taxes in effect at the scheduled closing time for receipt of Bid Proposals shall be stated. Payment of any change of rate of Gross Receipts Taxes that take effect during the performance of the Contract shall be allowed as a corresponding change in the Contract Price, provided however, that the Water Authority's payment to the Contractor of such Gross Receipts Tax rate change shall be only for progress payments or other billings submitted under the provisions of the Contract on or after the date the rate change goes into effect.

**Special Instructions on Entering Gross Receipts Tax Where Different Tax Rates Apply.**

In the event the Work on the Project is within areas where different New Mexico Gross Receipts Tax Rates apply, the applicable tax rate for each such area and the estimated percentage of the Work to be performed in each such area is provided in this form. All Bidders shall use the rate and percentage provided only for purposes of calculating the Bid. **Gross Receipts Tax Surety Bond.** Section 7-1-55 NMSA 1978 provides that any person engaged in the construction business who does not have its principal place of business in New Mexico and enters into a prime construction contract to be performed in this State, for which Gross Receipts Taxes will exceed \$50,000, shall at the time such contract is entered into, furnish the Secretary of the New Mexico Taxation & Revenue Department or the Secretary's delegate with a surety bond, or other acceptable security, in a sum equivalent to the gross receipts to be paid under the Contract multiplied by the applicable rate of the Gross Receipts Tax imposed by Section 7-9-4 NMSA 1978, plus the applicable rate of local Gross Receipts Taxes, to secure payment of the tax imposed on the gross receipts from the Contract, and shall obtain a certificate from the Secretary of the New Mexico Taxation & Revenue Department or the Secretary's delegate that the requirements of this Section have been met.

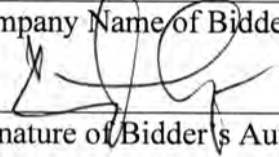
