**Item 9 – Water 2130 and Climate Change and Supply – Greg Gates**

Greg Gates presented Upper Rio Grande Impact Assessment data, climate change data and associated supply in Water 2120, Rio Grande climate changes since Water 2120, San Juan Chama yield under climate change scenarios, climate change in Water 2130 – RGBS-UMASS and Coupled Model Intercomparison Project (CMIP6) data. Mr. Gates and Mr. Kelly requested TCAC input on modeling data for use in future studies.

**Item 10 –Water Report– Mark Kelly**

Mark Kelly presented Water Report with supply metrics, groundwater pumping 113% of goal, gallons per capita per day (GPCD) 125 below goal of 133 GPCD, December had high temperatures, discussed precipitation and seasonal outlook.
