Water Authority Activity Status

- Reviewed CB&I's Resource Conservation & Recovery Act (RCRA) Facility Investigation Report (RFI). NMED decision on document pending.
- Continued participation with the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) and other stakeholders in interim measure / investigation discussions.
- Participated in “Complex Site Investigation” meeting led by Air Force Civil Engineering Center (AFCEC).
- Postponed finalization of Contingency Plan with AFCEC until data from new sentinel wells has been evaluated.

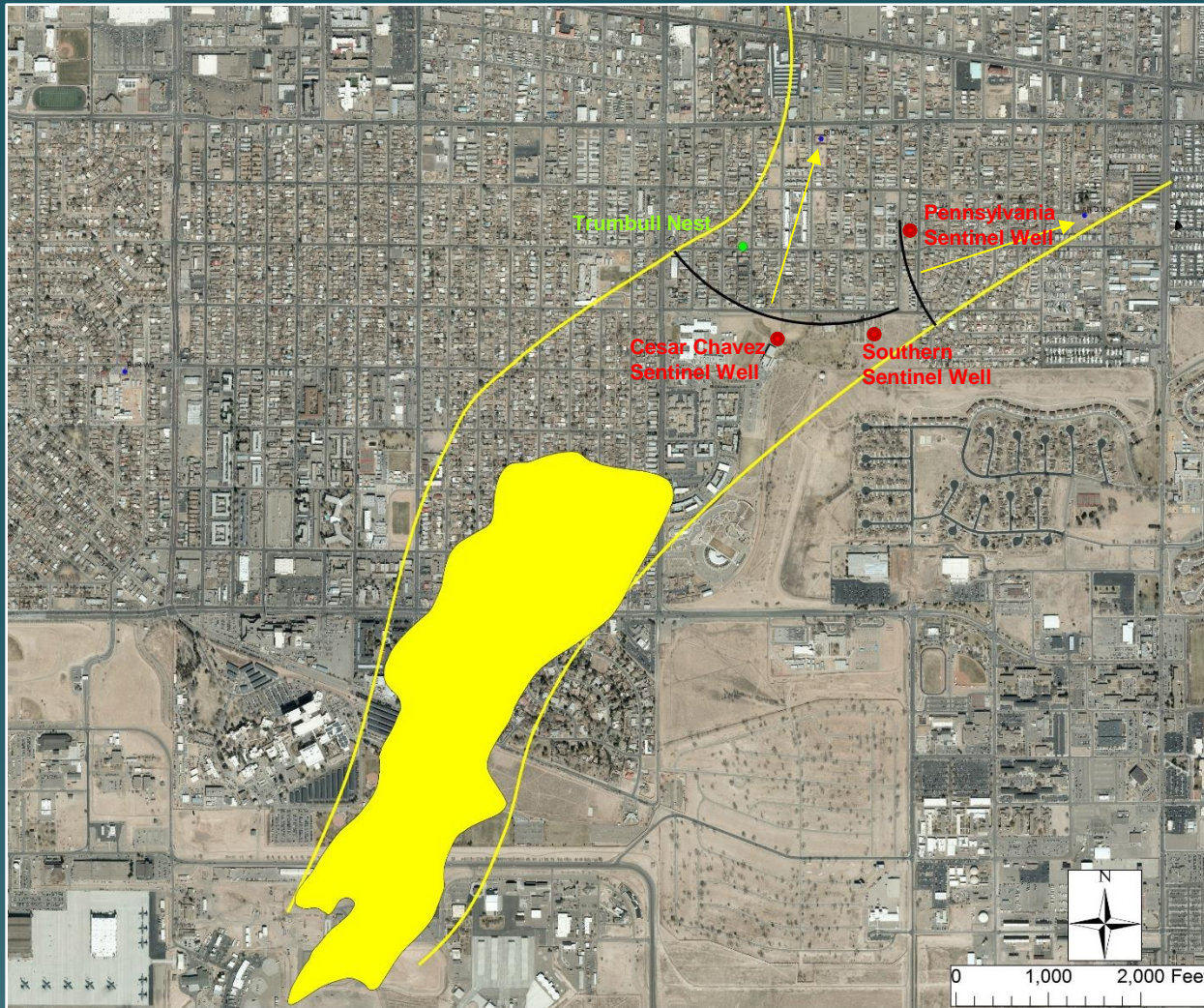


US Geological Survey (USGS) Sentinel Well Drilling

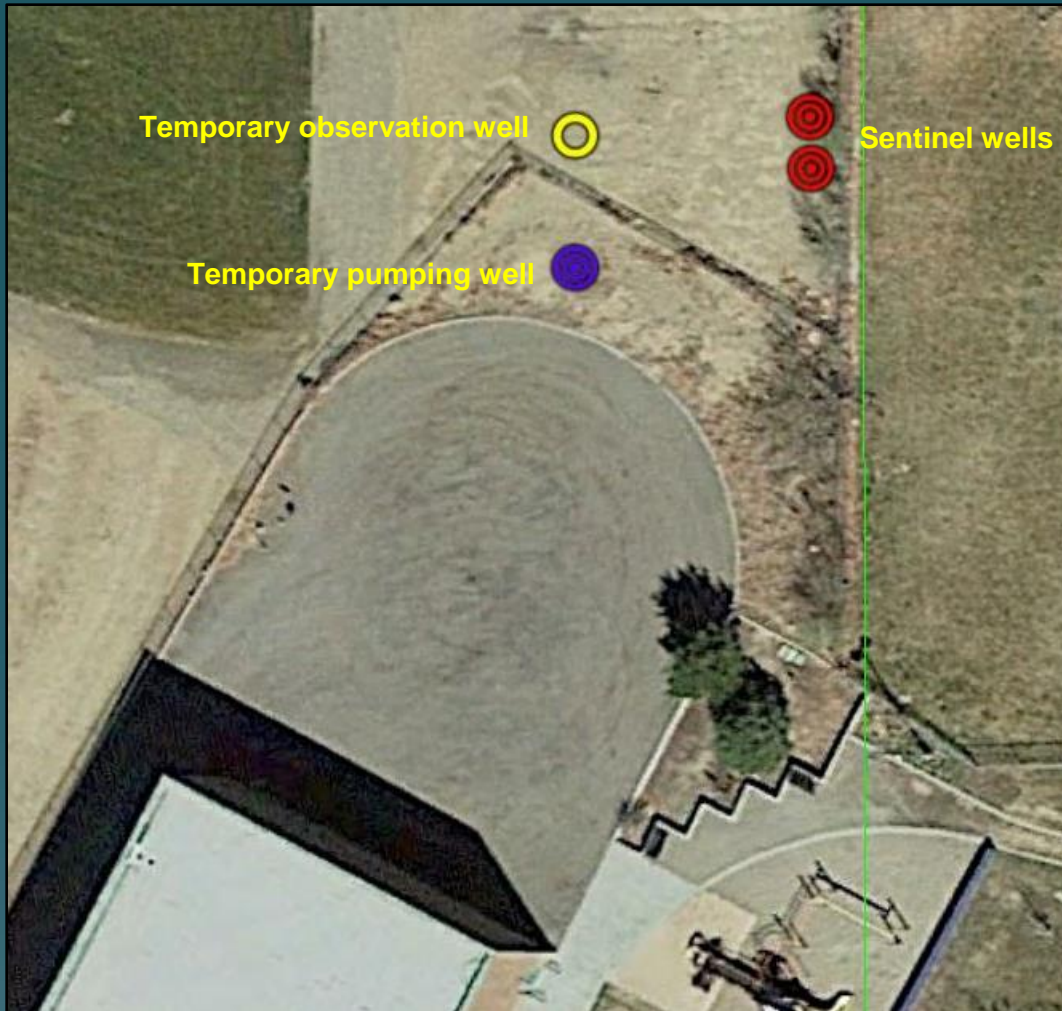
- WUA Board Requests for Sentinel Wells
 - WUA Resolution R-12-13 (2012)
 - WUA Resolution R-12-14 (2013)
 - WUA Resolution R-14-11 (2014)
- Sentinel wells separate from “corrective action” activities occurring for the bulk fuels facility spill and funded by AFCEC.
- Multiple wells at three locations to be drilled from this month until Jan. 2015.
