TITLE: R-25-32 – Authorizing the Albuquerque Bernalillo County Water

Utility Authority to Apply for Funding to the Water Trust Board for the

Expansion of the Drinking Water Treatment Plant Large-Scale Recharge (ASR) Project; Repealing and Replacing a Prior

Authorization for this Purpose

ACTION: Recommend Approval

SUMMARY:

This Resolution authorizes the Albuquerque Bernalillo County Water Utility Authority (Water Authority) to submit an \$22,000,000 application in the to the New Mexico Water Trust Board for the Expansion of Drinking Water Treatment Plant Large-Scale Recharge Project (ASR Project). The ASR Project enables the storage of San Juan-Chama water within the aquifer to meet future demand, particularly during years when surface water supplies are limited. Resolution R-25-29 granted the Water Authority approval to submit an application for \$18,000,000 in funding; however, due to increased project costs, the requested amount has subsequently risen.

As a critical component of the Water Authority's 100-year Water Plan (Water 2120), the ASR Project supports long-term water resiliency. Requested funding will support permitting, design, and construction for the next phase of the full-scale direct injection recharge initiative, expanding the Water Authority's capacity to recharge and stored water for future use.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The Water Authority will provide a required funding match, equivalent to \$3,600,000, which will be drawn from appropriated capital funds.

7	WHEREAS, the Albuquerque Bernalillo County Water Utility Authority (Water
8	Authority) intends to seek funding through the New Mexico Water Trust Board (WTB)
9	through the New Mexico Finance Authority (NMFA) for the expansion of its Drinking
10	Water Treatment Plant Large-Scale Recharge (ASR) Project; and
11	WHEREAS, the ASR Project enables the storage of San Juan-Chama water
12	within the aquifer system to support future demand, particularly during periods of limited
13	surface water supply availability; and
14	WHEREAS, the ASR Project represents a critical component of the Water
15	Authority's 100-year Water Plan (Water 2120); and
16	WHEREAS, the Water Authority requested \$22 million in WTB funding and
17	commit to providing a local match, totaling approximately \$3.6 million; and
18	WHEREAS, the Water Authority Board previously approved R-25-29 which
19	authorized a request for \$18 million in WTB funding for this ASR Project, and this
20	resolution is intended to repeal and replace R-25-29 for purposes of updating the
21	funding amount to \$22 million.
22	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WATER AUTHORITY:
23	Section 1. That the Water Authority is hereby authorized to apply for NMFA
24	WTB funding in support of the ASR Project in the amount of \$22 million.
25	Section 2. That the Water Authority shall contribute approximately \$3.6 million
26	in matching funds for the project.
27	Section 3. That the Executive Director shall have the authority to enter into an

agreement associated with the financial assistance.

- 1 Section 4. That the Executive Director is directed to coordinate with the NMFA
- 2 and WTB to meet all applicable deadlines and requirements associated with entering
- 3 into a cooperative agreement.
- 4 Section 5. This resolution repeals and replaces R-25-29.
