


## What & Why: CMOM

- Required by EPA as a part of Water Authority Permit

  - CMOM Program Self-Assessment




# Sanitary Sewer Overflow (SSO) Analyses

- Reportable SSO: May impact the Waters of the US
- Property Damage SSO: Results in damage to private property
- All Reportable and Property Damage SSOs are studied to determine Cause & Mitigation
- Also CCTV all Backups (near miss)






# Sanitary Sewer Overflow (SSO) Analyses


