TITLE: R-25-39 – Authorizing the Albuquerque Bernalillo County Water

Utility Authority to Submit an Application for Funding to the New Mexico Environment Department Clean Water State Revolving Fund

for a Non-Potable Water Reuse Treatment Plant

**ACTION:** Recommend Approval

## SUMMARY:

This Resolution authorizes the Albuquerque Bernalillo County Water Utility Authority (the "Water Authority") to submit a funding application of up to \$400 million to the New Mexico Environment Department's Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) for the development and construction of a Non-Potable Water Reuse Treatment Facility.

The purposed project includes construction of a new Non-Potable Water Reuse Treatment Plant along with supporting infrastructure such as reuse water distribution pipelines and pumping stations. Recycling water for both potable and non-potable uses is the foundational component of the Water Authority's long-term resource management strategy, Water 2120. This 100-year plan recognizes the need to secure new water sources to support future population growth and address the uncertainties posed by climate change. Water reuse leverages existing resources to help close projected supply gaps, but its implementation will require sustainable investment in new infrastructure.

## **FISCAL IMPACT:**

The Water Authority would repay the requested loan amount up to \$400 million at an interest rate of 0.01%. Additional grant subsidy funding is pending.

6	WHEREAS, the Albuquerque Bernalillo County Water Utility Authority (Water
7	Authority) intends to seek funding from the New Mexico Environment Department
8	(NMED) Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) for the construction of a Non-
9	Potable Water Reuse Treatment Plant; and
10	WHEREAS, water recycling both potable and non-potable uses is a cornerstone
11	of the Water Authority's long-term resource management strategy, Water 2120.; and
12	WHEREAS, the proposed Non-Potable Water Reuse Treatment Plant supports
13	the Water Authority's 100-year vision by enabling the reuse of water for irrigation of
14	parks, schools, and other recreational areas, thereby conserving high-quality drinking
15	water for essential uses; and
16	WHEREAS, the Water Authority anticipates requesting up to \$400 million in
17	funding from NMED CWSRF to support the planning, design, and construction of the
18	Non-Potable Water Reuse Treatment Plant.
19	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WATER AUTHORITY:
20	Section 1. That the Water Authority is hereby authorized to submit an
21	application to the New Mexico Environment Department Clean Water State Revolving
22	Fund for funding to support the Non-Potable Water Reuse Treatment Plant.
23	Section 2. That the Executive Director is authorized to enter into any
24	agreements necessary to secure and administer the financial assistance.
25	Section 3. That the Executive Director shall coordinate with NMED CWSRF to
26	ensure compliance with all deadlines and requirements for entering into a cooperative
27	agreement.
