TITLE: R-25-11 – Authorizing the Albuquerque Bernalillo County Water Utility Authority to Accept Grant Award/ Agreement with the New Mexico Department of Finance and Administration for the Aquifer Storage and Recovery Project

ACTION: Introduction and Immediate Action Requested

SUMMARY:

This Resolution authorizes the Albuquerque Bernalillo County Water Utility Authority (Water Authority) to enter into a Grant Award/Agreement in the amount of \$400,000 between the New Mexico Department of Finance and Administration (DFA) Infrastructure Planning and Development Division for the Aquifer Storage and Recovery (ASR) Project. The application for funding was approved by the Water Authority Board on November 20, 2024.

The ASR Project provides the ability to store San Juan-Chama water in the aquifer to meet demand, particularly in years of limited surface water supply availability. The ASR Project is a vital part of the Water Authority's 100-year Water Plan (Water 2120). This request would fund the match for a WaterSMART Grant for permitting, design, and construction of the next phase of the existing full-scale direct injection recharge project, increasing the Water Authority's capacity for recharge and stored water for future use. This new ASR project is located at the Arroyo del Oso (ADO) golf course.

This Resolution provides the Executive Director with the authority to enter into an Agreement with the New Mexico DFA Infrastructure Planning & Development Division related to this funding and all established deadlines.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The Water Authority was granted the WaterSMART Planning and Project Design Grant for the ASR Project in the amount of \$400,000 and this funding will meet the match requirements.
