Approving Service Connection Agreement for Water and Sewer Service with Taco Cabana of El Paso, Inc. at 10200 Coors Blvd. Bypass NW

Taco Cabana of El Paso, Inc. desires to connect to existing water and wastewater infrastructure located at 10200 Coors Blvd. Bypass NW. The proposed development is a Taco Cabana restaurant to be located within an existing retail center. The development is located outside of the Water Authority's Service Area, but within the City of Albuquerque. No additional infrastructure requirements are needed to provide water and wastewater service to this property other than a service agreement approved by the Water Authority Board.

As a condition of service, the owner will be required to:

- Comply with the ordinances, resolutions, plans, and regulations of the Water Authority
- Obtain concurrent water and wastewater service
- Pay the Utility Expansion Charge (UEC) at the rates that are imposed at the time of a service connection
- Pay the Water Supply Charge
